

Agenda: Future Creators Exhibition by Cheryl Jenkins

Overview

The Future Creators Exhibition will showcase young artists from grades 1st through 5th. Each participating artist will create a cohesive collection of 3 to 5 pieces. PNC will provide a \$100 stipend to each artist for supplies.

Residency Details

This program will operate as a 6-month residency where each student artist is paired with an artist mentor. They will meet bi-weekly to review progress, receive guidance, and learn techniques such as creating prints.

Exhibition Schedule

- Duration: Three-day event (Friday–Sunday)
- Exhibition Day: Sunday, 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM
- Format: Artists will be present during the exhibition.
- Sales: Each piece will have a QR code linking to purchase options for the original work or prints.

Partnerships and Responsibilities

- 78th Street Studios: Provide meeting space for the bi-weekly artist/mentor sessions.
- Jen Girardi (Ms. G): Offer oversight for bi-weekly meetings, manage supply check-ins, and recommend students who would be a strong fit for the exhibition.

2. Finalize exhibition dates and location logistics.
3. Establish marketing plan and promotional materials.
4. Schedule and organize bi-weekly mentor sessions.
5. Coordinate with PNC for stipend distribution and supply support.
